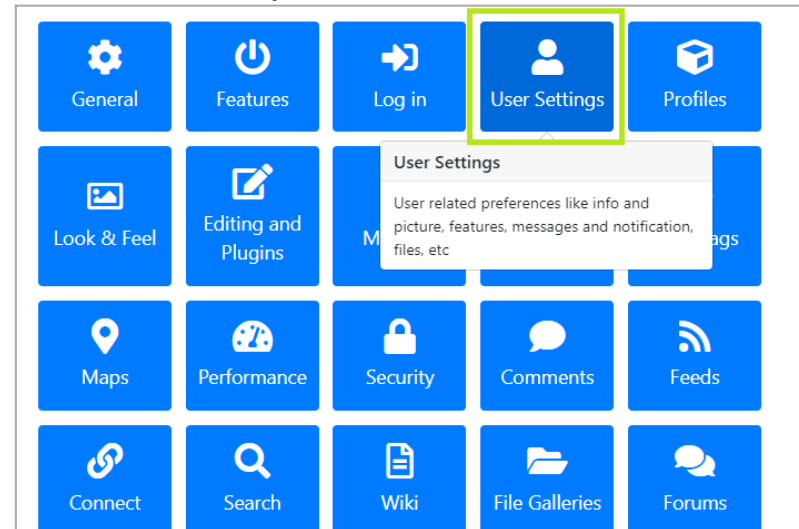


Enable personal information Pop-up

User information is made private by default to make it public, e.g. to display it when a user is mentioned there are a few steps to follow:

Step 1: Go to "User Settings"


Go to the control panel and select "User Settings".

Step 2: Activate the preference "User preferences screen"

In the tab "User Settings" activate "User preferences screen" and apply the changes.


