

Plugin USERINGROUP

Introduced in Tiki15 and backported to Tiki 12.5 and Tiki14.2

Use this wiki plugin to check whether a specific userId is in a designated Group and display defined text for either case

Parameters

checks if an individual user is in a particular Group and simply return a string set to either true or false

Preferences required: wikiplugin_useringroup

| Parameters | Accepted Values | Description | Default | Since |
|--------------------------|-----------------|--|---------|-------|
| <code>testgroup</code> | text | the Group that the userId check is made against | | 15.0 |
| <code>userId</code> | text | the userId to be checked | | 15.0 |
| <code>false{text}</code> | text | The text that is displayed if the test result is false | false | 15.0 |
| <code>true{text}</code> | text | The text that is displayed if the test result is true | true | 15.0 |

Example

This code:

```
{useringroup userId="admin" testgroup="Registered" truetext="the user IS in the Group" falsetext="the user is  
NOT in the Group"}
```

Would produce on this site:
the user IS in the Group
