

Using Machine Learning Models

After a model has been trained, it is ready to be used to make prediction on new data. Trying to use an untrained model will result in an error.

To use a model, open its action menu and click on **Use**.

Tiki will then display the model's page for prediction. This page will include input fields for you to enter new data.

Fill in the fields and select the type of task you want model to perform. This will be either a probability or prediction task. Either of the tasks is supported based on the model's underlying learning algorithm. After this, click on the **Submit** button to get result.
